 Applications for the Emergency Broadband Benefit Program are no longer available. Starting on Friday, December 31, 2021 you may apply for the Affordable Connectivity Program. To learn more about the Affordable Connectivity Program, please visit [ACPBenefit.org](https://www.acpbenefit.org). You may still apply for the Lifeline program during this time.

You Qualify for the Affordable Connectivity Benefit! Now, it's time to sign up with a provider.

Your application has been approved. If you haven't already done so, your next step is to sign up with a participating internet company by 4/8/2022 (based on US Eastern Time) so you can begin receiving discounted broadband service through the Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP).

If you do NOT sign up by 4/8/2022, you will have to reapply for the [Affordable Connectivity Benefit](#).

Even if you want to receive the benefit from your current broadband service provider, you still need to contact them to start receiving the benefit.

How to Sign Up with a Provider

Contact an [internet company](#) to pick a service plan and begin receiving your monthly [Affordable Connectivity Benefit](#) discount.

If you are interested in a connected device, [click here for a list of companies that offer connected devices](#). Not all companies participating in the program are offering connected devices. You will

need to enroll with a company to receive your broadband AND device benefit.

- 2** Tell the provider that you have been approved by the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC).
