Your application has been approved. If you haven't already done so, your next step is to sign up with a participating internet company by 7/30/2022 (based on US Eastern Time) so you can begin receiving discounted internet service through the Affordable Connectivity Benefit Program.

If you do NOT sign up by 7/30/2022, you will have to reapply for the Affordable Connectvity Benefit.

Even if you want to receive the benefit from your current internet company, you still need to contact them to start receiving the benefit.

How to Sign Up with an Internet Company

Contact an <u>internet company</u> to pick a service plan and begin receiving your monthly Affordable Connectivity Benefit discount.

If you are interested in a connected device, click here for a list of internet companies that offer connected devices. Not all internet companies participating in the program are offering connected devices. You will need to enroll with an internet company to receive your internet AND device benefit.

Tell the internet company that you have been approved by the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC).
